

Domestic Abuse Programme for Kent and Medway

Are you worried about your behaviour towards your partner?

This 12 session group programme for men aims to explore and address abusive and controlling behaviour within heterosexual, intimate relationships. The group will increase your awareness of the effects of your behaviour on partners and children, whilst developing the skills you need to reduce harm and to maintain respectful relationships.

The first session will be an individual session to introduce you to the programme and the group leaders. You will also have an opportunity to discuss any other questions you may have. You will be asked to sign an agreement which sets out the expectations for attending the group.

We will be running further programmes in Chatham and Ramsgate later this year.
